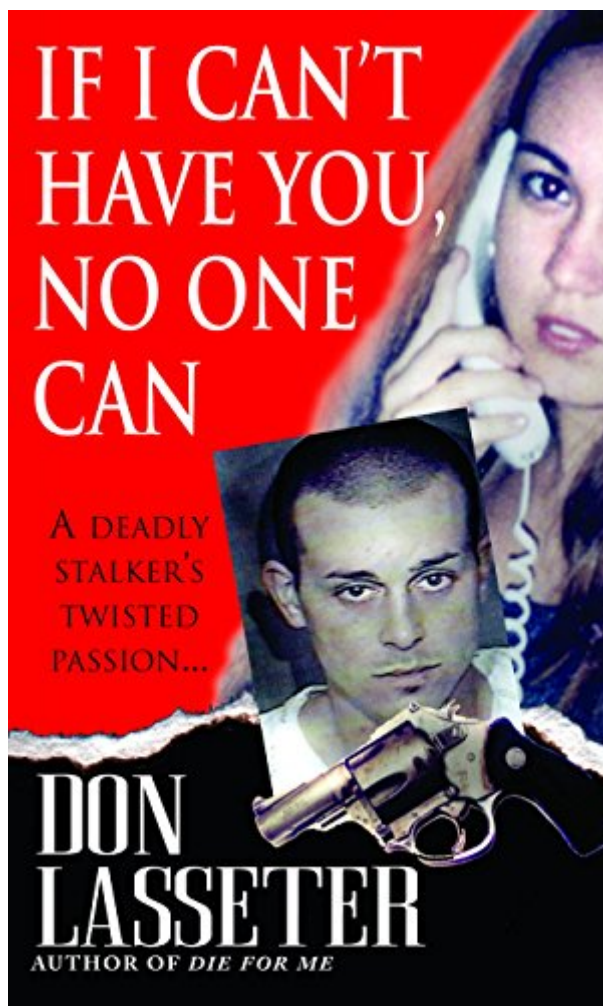


The book was found

In no way did she deserve what Namely did to her, I'm simply saying Matt even less. Anyway, great book, author and true character, ie. Conway. Highly recommend.

Pretty good telling of a really tragic story. The biographical details of the four main characters were well done. I especially like the fascinating story of the prosecutor's life. The only knock I have on it is that it did tend to drag at times probably could have been a little bit shorter. The story itself is tragic but I think the picture painted of the girl is a little bit one-sided. She's not quite the angel she's painted out to be obviously because it was her poor choices that led to the tragic results. Recommended.
