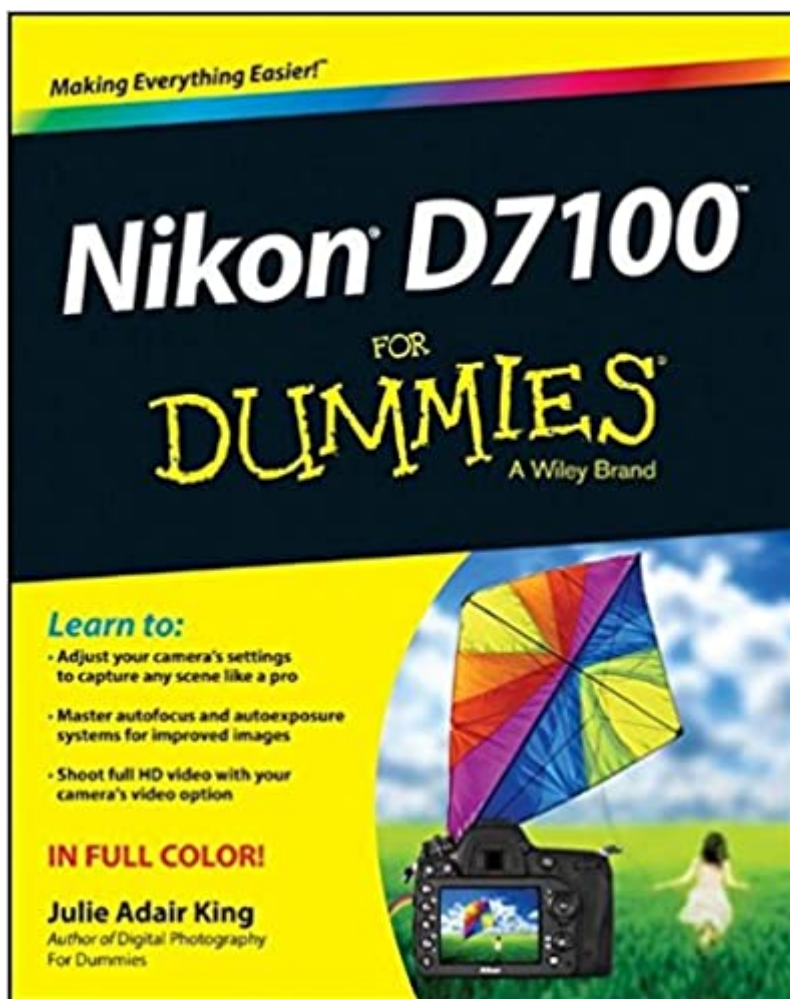

The book is arranged to be able to target those specific aspects of the D7100 that you want, without getting bogged down in the explanations of photography - if you already understand basic principles.

Far more helpful than the manual which just lays out the facts but is not user friendly. This book is put together by someone who gets behind all the jargon and it is easy reading and it is interesting and the layout is good. I now appreciate the Nikon7100 more.
