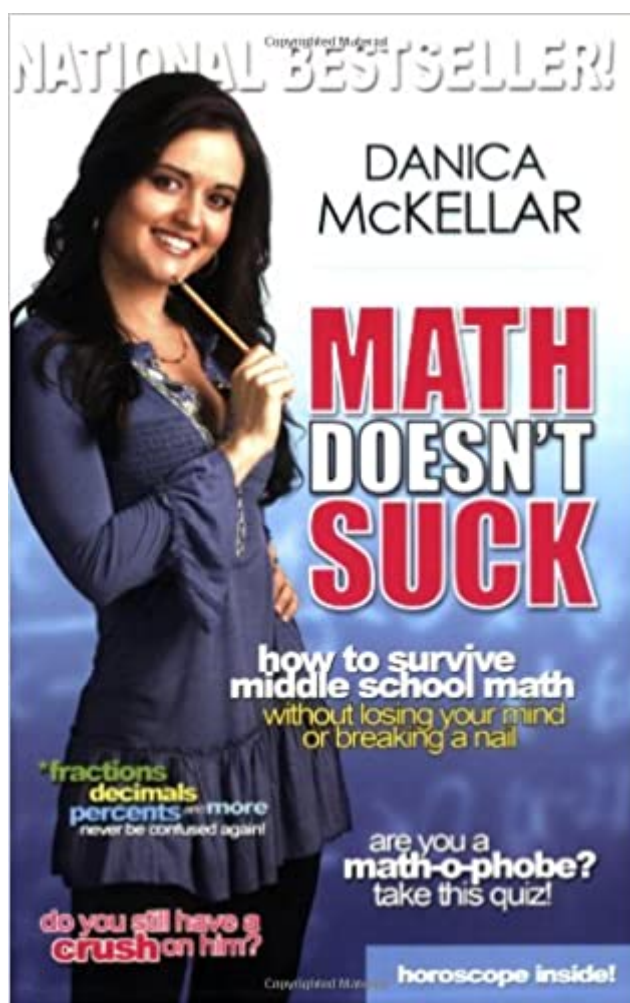

I love this book. Danica puts you in real life situations and uses math to help you understand how to apply and solve math problems within these real life situations. She explains everything clearly and also gives you little tricks along the way to help make math faster and easier. I bought this for my 13 year old to help her understand what she did last year in school from a different perspective and to help her keep her math skills up during the summer months.... It has done both and my daughter loved the book.

Middle school is really tough on our kids, more so than High School as our children have to learn more responsibilities while going through physical changes. Danica, relates to the reader about her struggles in school, and how to overcome them. She also teaches math in a way that the kids can understand. Remember this book is more geared towards girl. I am sure the math parts will be great

tools to teach the boys, but the stories are from a girls perspective.

Bought this with the intention of reviewing it for possible inclusion in our church library to help out kids. Ms. McKellar does an excellent job explaining the topics. While the book is intended for girls, boys will also benefit. Her teaching style is very down to earth and I wish someone like her would have been around when I was young.

Absolutely the best book around for kids who have a large discrepancy between their aptitude, enjoyment, and competence in language tasks versus mathematical ones. McKellar sits next to the student and chats in an animated and engaging way throughout the lesson, helping the verbal student learn to use her strengths to mediate the process. I only wish she'd write an additional version that was less girly. I've used this book with middle school boys I tutor, apologizing profusely at the outset for all the references to being female. They have agreed with me at the end that the explanations are so clear -- so "different from regular books", one boy said -- that they pretty much forgave me. Pretty much. In short, this is an awesome book -- but we need another that covers the same ground in the same way but using different examples and a slightly different tone. McKellar, are you out there? :+)

I am a homeschooling Mom with 10 years of teaching experience. My 13-year old used to love math. But, somewhere along the line, it went from fascinating and exciting to terrifying and depressing. She has fought me tooth and nail over the last few years with math. Along comes Danica. For the first time I can remember in many years, my girl is about to finish an entire math book in one-year!! Hooray! She still doesn't love math. But, like Danica says, "Math doesn't suck," so she gets it now. Thank you Danica for writing such a cool book!!

Our granddaughter found this book just what she needed to turn around her math grades. She now knows math is fun.

I ended up purchasing all three of her books. I am older and was going back to college, I remembered nothing about math. After reading her books I passed Algebra with a 95%. Then my son used them, he is 16 and now is amazing in math. Now my 12 yr old daughter is using them, she is terrible in math. I know by the time we go through all these books she will be an A student! Great books, I recommend them to everyone..I'll update this once my daughter finishes all the books.

I bought this after scanning the copy the library had. I was impressed enough to think it would be a very good resource for my grandkids as they are all going to be at this age and schooling level.
