

The fourth entry is a great companion to the third. St Clare is the obvious other half of the St Francis story and this time it is Katie's turn to visit Assisi about 7 years after her brother visited in the third book. At St Anne's it is Vocation Day, the boys go visit and play soccer with some Franciscans and the girls go to a Poor Clares monastery and shadow the nuns. Katie and Patrick are also trying to plan a birthday party that will please their friends - salon day and extensive video gaming. While

visiting the Poor Clares, Katie rings the bell for prayers and finds herself in Assisi. She meets Clare by following a cat to her home. Clare is just about to flee to Francis to become a new kind of nun, one who shuns the worldly things like Francis and his followers. We see the places she took refuge and finally her installation at the very church Patrick helped build in the third book with its friendly church mouse, Bernard. We also see the San Damiano cross and Katie is taken aback by it and its multitudes of people. I loved this as when I first started attending a parish with this very cross, I thought hippies had run amok at our founding! It is truly beautiful symbolism, but very different for those not familiar with St Francis's creation. Katie learns a lesson about what it is to give and give up and returns home. Vocations, giving of yourself as a great gift, and St Clare are all represented well. Love this series.

It is hard to find good Christian books for younger readers that won't constantly preach at them. The Chime travelers series is the perfect series for such readers. I myself enjoyed the series, but loved that four of my teen great-nephews and great-nieces were able to share them with me. We have a tradition we have shared from the time they first started school. No matter where they live we have all picked a book and read it and shared our thoughts on each chapter and book as a whole. It was a good way to ensure we stayed in touch when living in separate states. Sometimes I end up having to juggle four to five books at a time, but it is something I started with their parents when they were young and now have continued with the next generation. The only complaint I got from my family was that the story ended. It was enjoyed by all of us and they asked questions about faith without prompting. Thank you Ms. Hendey I try to urge them in their faith, but sometimes can see a glazed look enter their eyes and fear I am pushing them away. This series has given me an opening I needed to discuss it with them. We have taught them from the cradle of our Lord and His teachings but that does not stop the worry of outside influences. The character of St Clare is presented as a human being with human frailties and not the perfect s the town of Assisi during the Saintly person. They can relate to Katie and follow her story of suddenly finding herself interest. I hope they will enjoy the other books in the series as well. My rating is 5 out of 5 stars.
