

Asthma covers the basics--how we breathe, how asthma is diagnosed, asthma triggers, medication and therapies, and ways to improve living spaces. Dyslexia introduces symptoms of the learning disorder, describes how it is diagnosed, and discusses the effect the condition has on everything from memory to music, math, and foreign languages. Helpful sidebars offering coping tips increase the volumes' usefulness. Both books are comprehensive and not written down for young people.
