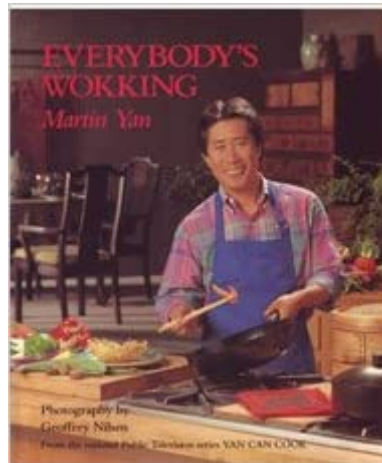

Recipes from the latest installment of the author's PBS series, *Yan Can Cook*, which began earlier this month. In addition to Cantonese and other Chinese dishes, many of them his mother's specialties, Yan includes his versions of a variety of recipes from other Asian cuisines. Now in its eighth year, the series has a large audience of devoted fans; other cooks who find Yan's wacky television persona a bit off-putting will in fact find an appealing array of serious recipes here. After taking a cooking class from the owner of a Thai restaurant about 18 years ago, I began a collection of Oriental cookbooks. I have to say that Yan's "Everybody's Wokking" - despite the cheesy title - is one of the best. Many of the recipes are extremely flavorful (not necessarily hot-spicy, although there are those, too), and the recipes feature flexibility and SIMPLICITY. Few have more than a dozen ingredients, and although you'll need an Asian food store for a few items, most of the ingredients can be found in a typical grocery store. I cook more recipes more consistently from this book than from any other. Lemon chicken - chunks of chicken breast, dipped in cornstarch and walnuts, deep fried and dipped in sweet and sour sauce built from lemon and ginger! The best pork chop recipe of my entire life, featuring Chinese five-spice, orange juice and

caramelized onions! Chicken thighs marinated in cilantro, garlic and turmeric and baked or grilled. Sweet and sour shrimp soup - with lime juice, cilantro, green onions, jalapeno, and mint! Flavors coming out your ears and eyes! Get it. Use it! It's great!

It has many great recipes that are fun to try. If you like Chinese food, it is a great help.

One of my all time favorites!! Try the sichuan chicken wings! So simple.

Helpful Woking
