

Positives: As far as information, it seems thorough and an easy read. Since that's the main thing I'm looking for, I'm happy and don't regret the purchase. The pictures are nice too, as they are large and help explain the text.Negatives: The editing is subpar (the title of Section III is "Patrolling Mehods"). The author is well qualified according to the "about the author", but you wouldn't know if from his level of professionalism- plenty of bad jokes consistently throughout that might fly in a classroom environment but are inappropriate and unnecessary in a book. The quality of the binding and paper is good enough for home library, but I have the feeling it wouldn't stand up well to adverse environmental conditions, or even to loaning it out. It's much larger than I expected, which isn't necessarily bad (the pictures are helpful, as previously mentioned), but I was hoping for something a little more portable.

For folks preppling this is a must, especially for those in rural and light urban area's, there is a huge difference between protecting your home and protecting your land (AOPS) a good defense should be also a good offense. Its better to 'patrol' through your area of operations (AOPs) and counter any offensive forces who intend to do you harm and the only way to do that is to practice LITS (Light Infantry Tactics)So if you don't have a former grunt in your team this is the book, and even with a

grunt this will help him train your team to a decent standard. Well Done Chris

It's been 25 years since I was in the military, and when I was in, all I did was race motorcycles. Later, I did some "other work" so patrolling and map reading was old hat, but ambush, counter-ambush, raids, etc. were foreign to me. The author does a good job of setting up the process and follows up with true story examples. I was expecting a small pocket book, but it is a full size 8 by 11 book, which makes it easy reading, but tough packing around.

Review of material I learned a long time ago. Easy to read and understand. Just read a chapter and go practice.

I wish that I had have read more reviews (especially the negative ones) prior to ordering. If you got this far, I just saved you \$20 or so. DO NOT BUY THIS BOOK! It is a total waste of money. This book has nothing to offer anyone but a civilian with a mild curiosity in the subject or airsoft and paintball wannabe's (surprise surprise that's what he is writing about these days). You can get everything that is in this book for free online at sites like global security and army pubs. I wish I could return it.

Chris Larson is a pro. This is basically the US Army FM 7-8 Field Manual. It covers all the same info and just as in depth. However, unlike FM 7-8, this is written in a format easily digestible for any person. Military manuals are very dry and hard to understand. This is written so as any layperson can pick it up, and if they practice, can learn the fundamentals.

The product was as stated. The presentation and delivery was on point. The book itself has some interesting points and incite. However, most of the meat within the book is a cliff note version of the US Army Infantry manual that you can score for free on the Internet or from your buddies in service. With that aside, I do give the book credit. It cuts out a lot of the manual dryness. It also cuts out a lot of the nonsense that a non-military individual would not need to know or have access to.
