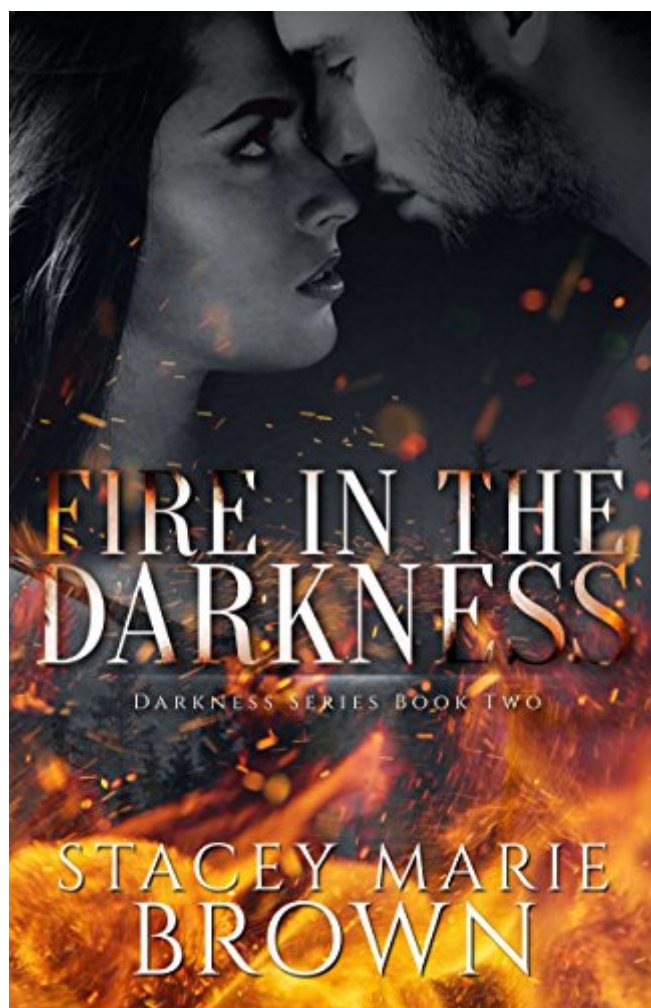

As the blurb says, this one picks up about four weeks after Ember destroys Seattle. She has been constantly on the run from the Seelie Queen's minions and all others hunting her for profit. She does her best to stay away from people because, while they provide a bit of protection, they are definitely not safe from her uncontrolled powers. She thinks she's been doing a good job of it all until she gets cornered and Eli comes to her "rescue". Turns out he's been doing his damndest to keep all who would harm her away from her without getting too close to her so that she runs when she feels him near. She becomes a prisoner of a sort on the dark dweller compound for a little while until one of her biggest fears comes to pass. Angry at pretty much everybody, she runs away. And runs and runs. Then passes out. To wake up in the Unseelie King's house. Making a deal with him, she is trained to control the various aspects of her power as well as gets some history lessons here and there. Her progress with control leaves much to be desired, but it stems from her not quite letting go of thinking like a human. The people there are almost like a family and not at all what she was expecting, and she starts to even like some of them. She's been there for a few months I think and has been feeling Eli's presence outside the wards for a while. One night she decides to cross them and pick a fight with him. But that does a 180 fast enough leaving both of them blissfully happy for a few hours. But of course, Lorcan has to show up and ruin everything. He tells Ember something she just doesn't want to believe, and she runs away...again. This time to do something stupid. But she is stupidly determined and pretty much manipulates Torin into helping her. Their plan starts out going well enough but soon goes way downhill. Setting Ember up for the shock of her life. But with a little help from a couple pixies, at least some good comes of her reckless actions and she makes it back to the Earth realm okay with others in tow. Only to have Eli appear and drop the bomb on her that while she thinks she's only been gone maybe a day or so, she's been gone from there for three years. And they have clearly had their effect on Eli. Ember learns much this time around, but it's clear that there are still a lot more secrets being kept from her. And some of them I can't help but speculate about. As much as I love Eli, I almost think he's better in a book than in person. I just don't know if I would like him as much if I actually had to deal with him. But when him and Ember are together it is just fantastic. Their relationship may be a to and fro of anger and tease but it is definitely entertaining. Their banter is probably one of my favorite parts. I was definitely surprised at who Lars turned out to be especially considering Torin kept telling Ember to find him. And speaking of Torin, I still don't like him. I don't trust him either. But I was not surprised as to the reason why he acts and talks the way he does toward Ember. I actually suspected as much in the last book...

This book follows Ember's path after the destruction of Seattle. She is running for her life in Seattle

where hiding among Humans to stay alive. So many things happen during this book that it keeps you truly interested in the events. It moves quicker than I expected it to move which was great. The story shows how Ember begins to truly accept who and what she is and learns both some of her history and how to use her powers. Just when you think things are setting down for Ember there is a twist you did not expect. I was very intrigued to know how it is that Lorcan is always able to find Ember and Eli. I am glad to see more secrets from her life revealed. Although I do not think she has learned all she has to learn. I am so glad she ran in to save her friends and family just not sure she should have gone alone. This book is a great book thus far. Can't wait for the next one!

Let me start with this: I read.. A LOT. I'm always reading something between juggling my two kids and getting things done that I need to get done. This is the first book I've felt the need to actually review.*** also there will be spoilers I'm sure*** Usually it's fairly easy for me to put a book down and be interrupted for something... Not the case with both of Stacey's books. I was absolutely hooked. I randomly recommended *Darkness of Light* for me and I decided to give it a try. I ended up reading the whole book in one sitting. I bought *Fire in the Darkness* before I even finished the first because I just knew that I wouldn't want to break between the two. First I have to commend the editing. I am a big critic of bad grammar and improper use of words while I'm reading. I can't remember one thing that I noticed that was wrong. So- either there weren't any mistakes, or I was just so involved in the story that I didn't take time to notice- whichever reason, it's a good thing and not something that I experience often. The characters are so likable and REAL. I can't tell you how many times I have read books and felt almost like a soap in book form. This was not one of those books. I love Eli and Ember together. They just work. They feed off of each other, piss each other off and compliment each other at the same time. I did walk around in a state of extreme sexual frustration the whole time I was reading this and *Darkness of Light* though. It was making me ornery and made me hate Lorcan even more because he always seemed to ruin it! The connection between them is something that got me. It wasn't just them being attracted to each other- there's something deeper than that. And the battle that Eli fights with his history with Ember's kind makes him all that more angsty and hot. He doesn't give in easily, like they do in most books. And then my favorite line "I'll follow you anywhere" my heart melted. Literally melted. I personally fell in love with him. My husband wasn't sure if I was talking about a real person or not when I was talking about him. And Ember's love for her family and friends is what drives her. It makes her do impulsive and stupid things, but it's something that makes her more relatable. I really admire her because she chooses to be strong even though every time she turns around someone else is lying to her or stabbing her in the back.

And then to find out... Well. I won't give that away. But there's something BIG! Anyway, after all of that (And I could write a lot more) I would sum it up to that I would highly recommend this to anyone who wants to read something really different (not just the same story with little tweaks to it- I haven't read anything like this one before), loves hot paranormal guys and a great plot (not just smut) it's an easy world to get sucked into. I finished two days ago and still cannot force myself to read any other books because I'm still so involved with this story. That just doesn't happen. Two thumbs way up!

Ember has been lied to, captured, tortured and escaped. She loves a dark dweller and has now lost her stepfather and her friends. She has been used to level Seattle. What else can go wrong? Ember leaves and finds the Unseely king. He takes her in and begins her training so she can face the queen. She has left Eli after all the drama, but knows he is still there. But can she get strong enough to defeat the queen? Time will tell. She has made a bargain with the king. If she breaks it, it might be her undoing. So what do you think happens? You got it. But it was for a good reason. And surprises await her when she crosses over to the Otherworld. Some good and some not. Read on my friends. This is fantastic.
