

Over 400 pages offering over 100 wild locations from the San Juan Islands to Salmo-Priest on the Canadian/Idaho border (yes, we've been there).Like many publications, most of the hikes are concentrated west of the Cascades. It's a personal beef of mine. Most authors are from the west side and don't really take the time to find out what lies beyond the mountains. "Thar be dragons," is the call. Regardless. There's plenty here for most anybody who wants to get out and about in the uncorrupted parts of the state.
