

Lauren Andersen has been weaving tiny jump rings for more than seven years. She teaches classes in chain mail at her local bead shops and major national craft shows. She is a member of the Beadalon Design Team and is a frequent guest on the popular television series Beads, Baubles, and Jewels and Jewelry Televisionâ ™s Jewel School.

Lauren Andersen, the "chain mail lady," already has 3 chain mail booklets and I have at least 10,

why not another? This fun, non-intimidating introduction to chain mail goes over the usual basics: types of wire, proper opening of jump rings, tools and other materials It doesn't go into great depth about aspect ratio but it's adequate enough for a beginner. There's some cursory information about different types of beads along with the Kalmbach standard wire tutorials: basic loop, wrapped loop and jump rings, not the in-depth one mentioned earlier. Andersen teaches 7 of the most popular and easiest weaves in the chain mail repertory in addition to a few bonus weaves. She starts with the European 4-in-1, with two variations, the sideways 4-in-1 and the 6-in-1. This is followed by the Mobius, aka flower or rosette, the byzantize (but no box chain) The Japanese 12-in-2, The Parallel, (celtic, helm), the double spiral, shaggy loops and the basic 3-in-3 chain. Andersen uses color coded aluminum jump rings (practice jump rings) which are slightly larger for teaching purposes, along with detailed, up close photos that are exceptionally clear and directions with each step. Some of the projects are standard, adding crystals or using different colored jump rings for interest and some are just inspired, the green bracelet on the cover uses eyeglass findings, and a twisted rhinestone bracelet with a lingerie finding. As in all of the Absolute Beginners series, picture of the finished project can be seen along with a design variation. Did I mention the photos were clear, no matter how up close they were? I don't have any of her booklets, but if you do, this is still a good purchase. And if you're new to chain mail or like to add to your chain mail library, this is still a great book.
