

This is the most direct approach to the mysterious Urantia Book I have read to date, and entirely original. Many new ways of seeing myself and life as a result.

This book is the third in a series Timothy Wyllie has produced over 27 years, and both summarises and surpasses its two predecessors: Dolphins, ETs and Angels, and Adventures Among Spiritual Intelligences. The previous two were explorations of the territory he probes, while this is a summation based on three decades of reflection and refining his ideas. The Urantia Book is a tough

nut for some people (this reviewer included), so Wyllie's taking it as a departure point requires some patience. And for UB fans, he is an iconoclast who believes the Lucifer Rebellion, which the text describes as the crucial event in earth's history, has ended. He therefore rankles the orthodox. However, The Return of the Rebel Angels covers the author's own spiritual autobiography, and an examination of his conclusions over the years, and he makes allowance for those who look askance at his beliefs and conclusions. The central notion he addresses, drawing on Urantia Book doctrines, is that Earth ("Urantia") became isolated from the rest of the cosmos during a rebellion staged by its spiritual guardians 200,000 years ago. All our subsequent history has been radically change from the expected norms of development as a result. This Lucifer Rebellion has, Wyllie says, been finally reconciled, and we're now in the throes of a very difficult readjustment. While he doesn't hold that December 2012 will see a definitive shift in our fortunes and destiny, he does believe it likely that a profound change will come then or soon after, and we need to be not just braced for it, but open to the liberating result of the crisis of these difficult times. The book's weakness is that he uses his own experiences as much of his primary testimony. One must trust his honesty as well as the validity of his encounters with odd individuals, ET-influenced events, or his various psychic and mystical openings. On that score, the book as a whole is his best advocate, since he is aware of the thin line he walks, and of how easy it is for a seeker to be wilfully self-deluded. The book's strength lies in its optimism, and Wyllie's open-minded intelligence. "It's not `a world that needs to be saved,' it's a playpen created for individual souls to wake up within," he declares in his preface, and what follows explores the implications of this idea. As his final chapter is called We're Doomed to be Perfect, it's plain he thinks any purgatorial aspects of the world's current material and spiritual conditions are passing phenomena. His concept of rebel angels is drawn from the Urantia Book, and assumes that large numbers of the beings who joined the Lucifer Rebellion are now working off their karma in human form. This also means they are entering a path of evolution, a process that's attracted other angelic beings not involved in the original rebellion at all. It's quite plain the book's primary appeal will be to the tens of millions of 'people' who have come from among such angelic ranks. "Angels have no need for strong emotional bodies since their range of choices is minimal," he notes on pg. 395. "The density and power of human emotions are notoriously hard to manage, even for humans, and incarnate angels in particular need to prepare themselves for the challenges of being mortal." This makes for some very tough, painful lives as they adjust to living in bodies. There are times when any honest person will find this book strains credulity. It requires a leap of imagination, and inevitably sparks some heart-searching as to how its implications affect our view of ourselves and our lives. But that is one of its virtues. It stirs some strange feelings, and touches on the kind of

thoughts many people keep secret in the private corners of their minds. Whether or not a reader accepts all the premises and conclusions in the book, there's plenty here to spark inner reflection and clear thought, and a convincing overall optimism that's hard to find in any commentary produced in these times.

Timothy does a wonderful job of relating thirty years of personal history with angels and Urantia midwayers. I have been a student of the Urantia Book for over thirty years and find his insight into the Lucifer rebellion to have a very positive christ-like attitude. I find myself in agreement with his assessment of the return of the Urantia midwayers and hosts of angelic groups, including those that were misled into rebellion to have such an exciting future. I think the possibility of the fallen angels having an opportunity to live as humans on the very planet where Christ Michael incarnated as Jesus was probably the most interesting consequence of having done what they did. I can imagine that they all jumped at the opportunity to receive a fragment of God as just compensation while they have the chance to experience what it is like for the rest of us to live on a planet so dreadfully scarred by Prince Caligatias' betrayal.
