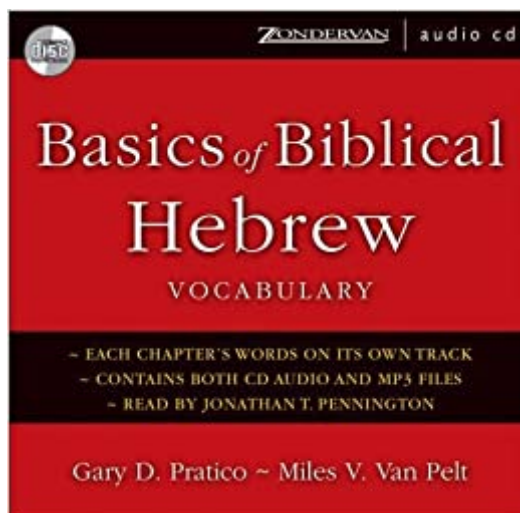

Gary D. Pratico (ThD, Harvard Divinity School) is senior professor of Old Testament and Hebrew language at Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary. He has been teaching Hebrew for more than thirty years and is coauthor with Miles V. Van Pelt of Basics of Basics of Biblical Hebrew (grammar

and workbook) and The Vocabulary Guide to Biblical Hebrew. Miles Van Pelt (PhD, Southern Baptist Theological Seminary) is the Alan Belcher Professor of Old Testament and Biblical Languages at Reformed Theological Seminary in Jackson, Mississippi, where he also serves as Academic Dean. Miles lives in Madison, Mississippi, with his wife, Laurie, and their four children.

If you are using it in a vehicle, you can switch tracks but it requires constant monitoring. If you are using it on a Windows 7 computer, you are not given the option to switch tracks though. You have to start from the beginning every time. So I have to listen to the alphabet, etc. to get to Chapter 11's vocabulary. This is an excellent product that is presented in a very poor format.

I am a first semester seminary student attending Talbot School of Theology at Biola University. I enrolled in the "Elements of Hebrew I" course, and we are using the "Basics of Biblical Hebrew Grammar" textbook and the "Basics of Biblical Hebrew" workbook. I bought the "Basics of Biblical Hebrew Vocabulary Audio CD" to aid my memorization of Biblical Hebrew vocabulary.

Pros: 1. The CD is divided into chapters that correspond directly to the vocabulary list at the end of each chapter in the textbook. 2. I paid \$11.04 for this CD, and I felt it was an appropriate price for the value of the product.

Cons: 1. Dr. Jonathan T. Pennington might be a good theologian and scholar, but why was he chosen to narrate this CD, or at least the Hebrew words on the CD? I would GREATLY prefer someone like... Rabbi Shlomo Ben Judah (made-up person), or something. Dr. Pennington has a great voice, but it's funny to listen to an obviously English-based pronunciation of Hebrew words.

Summary: I recommend this CD if you're learning Biblical Hebrew. Though the pronunciation of Hebrew words would be better without the influence of an English accent, the CD is still a great resource. The "mispronunciations" aren't disruptive to learning, and a concern regarding inaccuracy is a non-issue for the most part since there is no way to prove absolutely that Biblical Hebrew was pronounced one way with certainty over another. Would I pay twice the cost for a more Jewish accent? Actually, yes. But the \$11 price point is great for what I received, and this CD is far more convenient than having to record my own voice for each chapter.

Listen to the vocabulary words over and over and over again, then listen again and again until you know each word by memory.
