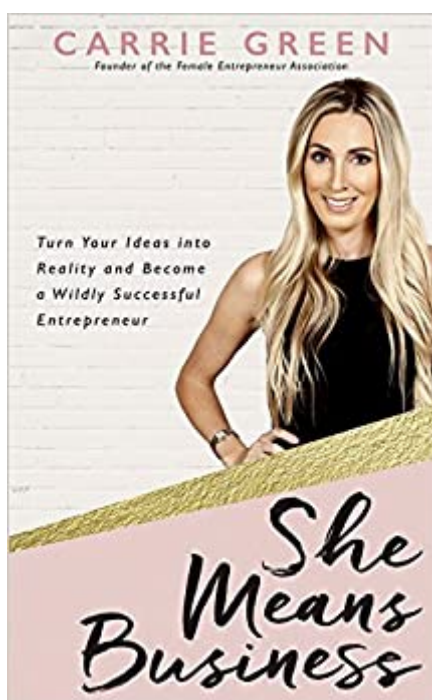

yourself, celebrating wins, take care of yourself, resisting the urge to put things off, I love all the examples of real life entrepreneurs in the book, especially because I know who most of them are and have also watched their business being built from the ground up. I loved the book so much I even bought it on Audible. It reminded me why I love books that the authors read themselves. So much of Carrie's spirit comes through in her reading.
