This is probably the best, most complete Minecraft series I've ever read. The plot is very captivating, filled with action and adventure that goes beyond Minecraft; although the background is set in the game there are mazes, fast-paced battles, time travel and lots of plot twists that make this a deeply

thought series (unlike other short, simple Minecraft books I've read before). The writing style is interesting, illustrating the stories through different points of view, making sure the main protagonist isn't always the same and that every character plays an equal importance. The characters do not start out as heroes, but are pretty realistic, sometimes having to deal with treachery, loss, corruption, not to mention the amazing character development throughout all the journeys that Herobrine, SparkleGirl, Emman and the others live. As for the so-called "bad guys", they aren't the usual world-controlling people, they might be powerful, selfish players, or ancient legends waiting for an opportunity, or an entire loyal population following the wrong person. I really enjoyed this collection, even though it's actually 16 books compacted together that I managed to finish in one day, there are a couple of things I need to point out: 1) The punctuation is disastrous, there are dots, commas and question marks often out of place or missing (I had no particular problems understanding, but some readers might) 2) There is lots of killing and violence (i.e. slicing off arms and heads) and monstrous creatures (zombies, hell hounds) that, while not explicitly described, might cause a few problems (as for me, I wasn't affected by it since everything in Minecraft is blocky and not scary to me) 3) The last part about time-travel and parallel worlds was quite confusing, and I admit I didn't quite enjoy it as much as the previous adventures, but hopefully the next book (part 17, I'm waiting for the Kindle Unlimited version) will clear things up.

As long as I've been playing Minecraft, I've been obsessed with Herobrine. He is, like, the best thing that has happened to me. I searched long and hard for a series about Herobrine, and, hallelujah! At last I found it! Barry, thank you so much! And only for \$10?! At first, I couldn't believe my eyes. This series is sooooo good! The only things I didn't like was how Herobrine from the first dimension died and the end. I mean, it was a darned cliffhanger! I rate it, if I could, 20 stars. Praise for Barry and the Herobrine series! :)

This book series was so interesting that I couldn't place the Kindle down! I wish the series kept going on because it made me think every time I finished a chapter. I recommend this series to all. Hope you enjoyed it if you already read it because I did.

I would rate lower if it wasn't OK. I did not like how Herobrine was treated so cruelly. You should have let him find a wizard that granted him powers so he can get his revenge on ChuckBone. I think Sparkle should visit Herobrine on the future. I mean, I think that'll be even more cruel if she didn't since he did let her live in his house, and allow her to use his weapons. I would recommend it if you

like tragedies and backstabbing moments. I hate those parts. If they didn't have them and Herobrine was still there, I would rate higher. What also came to my attention is you can't be turned evil in Minecraft while playing the game in the real world. The author made it so the players were played by a real person. A real person cannot feel pain the his/her character feels. I know I'm sounding 'nerdy' right now, but I don't care because it doesn't stick to the main theme. The theme is that the people in the real world control the characters and should not be able to feel their character pain. It's only reasonable if your books are like the Gameknight999 series, which is not because you also clearly pointed out that Sparkle's older brother, John, is from the real world and is not a Minecraft character. As I said earlier, if you're a person who is into tragedies, and/or really like backstabbing moments, this series is for you. I can't make you not read it though. What I can do is suggest you not to read it (in my opinion). I really feel bad for Herobrine for what happened to him. I usually give pretty fun reviews, but I am seriously dissatisfied on what the results were. -MobMaster937
