Barbra Streisand has created a "museum" that poses as a "home." This book showcases her fine collection of American Decorative Arts. Her undisputed knowledge of her "show cased" pieces is outstanding. Unfortunately, her "assemblage" fails to create anything more than a personal statement about her love of design. Had Streisand seriously studied architecture and design -- she would have had a blazing career as an interior designer.Her fans will LOVE this book; however, this "house-as-a-stage-set" should,, in the future, be converted into a public museum and this book re-printed and placed in the "gift shop." It illustrates Streisand's talent but sadly reveals her lack of discipline and restraint. Had she enjoyed a rich career as a successful interior designer she would have learned a valuable lesson: "One should not show "all-they-know" in a single project.(I looked at

the photographs. I admired the respectful "homages;" and was horrified that she upholstered some Arts and Crafts pieces in "a favorite velvet" which clashes with the wood tone of the frames. I promptly re-gifted the book to one of her adoring and passionate"fans." They were, of course, thrilled to have this book from a talented entertainer.
