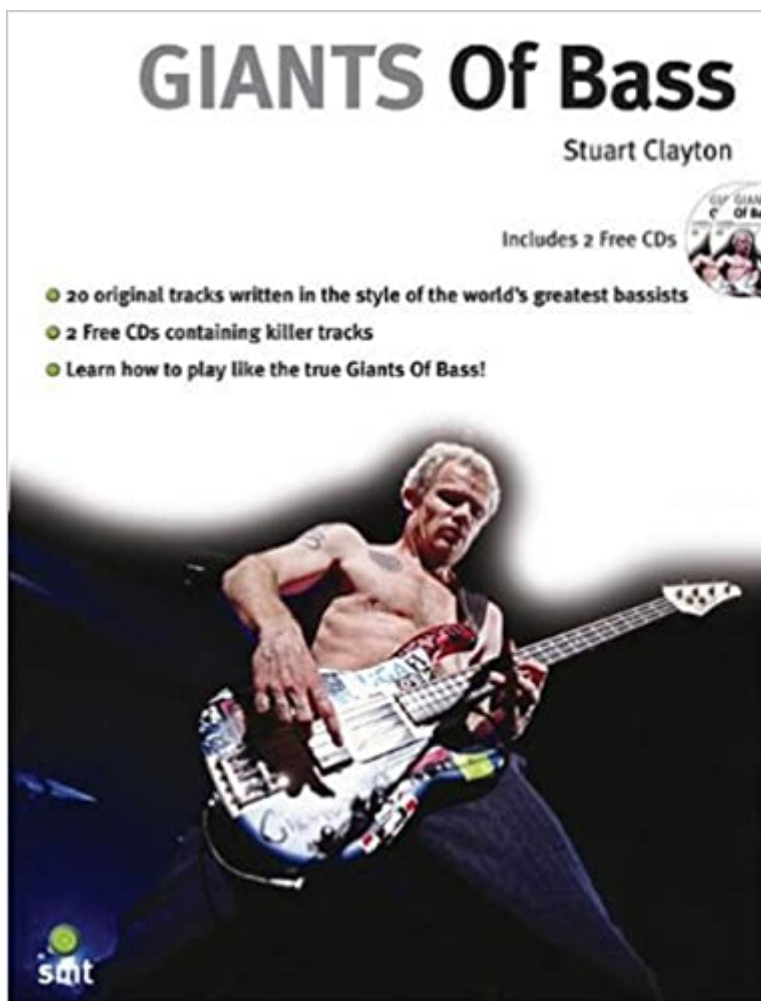

This book presents the styles of twenty of the best players of the electric bass instrument. This book is superb! There are two tracks for each of these famous players. The first track is with the bass line and the second track is without. This alone is a very worthy feature as you do not have to kill the left or right channel to have a backing track without bass. So once you learn the bass line, you have a backing track with both channels and no bass! Or, you can put your own bass line to it. The audio quality for the tracks is excellent and the tracks are interesting and a pleasure to listen to musically. The backing tracks are the best I have been able to find anywhere and I have spent considerable time looking. And you also get standard and tablature notation for each bass line! This is the highest quality product to support my learning the electric bass that I have come across thus far. I am very happy I purchased this product. I just bought the book and I love it. The book includes trademark licks in style of twenty bass masters and it is not just a bunch of licks to learn but well structured songs that is great fun to play!
