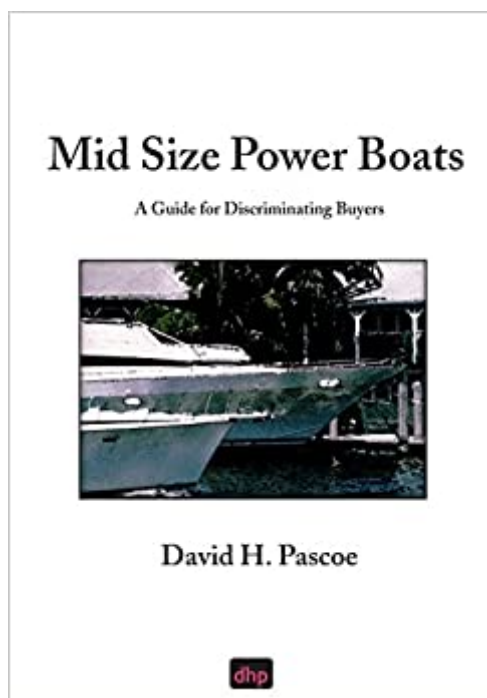

This book is full of a lot of good info. However, I hope the printed version is better organized. The author uses terms before he defines them (big No No) and some of the pictures (at least in the early chapters) don't exactly correlate with the text. One is flat out wrong (three pictures of boats - the text mixes up the left and right ones). I think (hope) that most of the problems I'm seeing with the book are because it's just poorly formatted for the Kindle app. It's actually a very informative book, easy

to read and understand, even for the novice boater. So I recommend it, but I'd recommend getting the hard copy version.

I was toying with the idea of spending a few hundred grand on a motor yacht but decided I need to try the rental route first after reading this excellent book. He made me really think about the time, budget, and pitfalls (and the benefits!) to carefully consider to make a good purchase.
