

The film features familiar figures from Sex Trafficking and the shocking conditions of their exploitation. It also includes cases Kara has uncovered since his book debuted. This new paperback edition of Sex Trafficking includes a preface by Kara in which he discusses his findings and updates the statistics relating to his business and economic analysis of contemporary slavery. After fifteen years, Kara has recorded nearly 900 cases of sex trafficking in forty-one countries and has helped advise on numerous legal, tactical, and policy efforts for abolishing modern-day slavery across the globe. Sex Trafficking continues to lead as a resource for those hoping to expose this hidden evil and eradicate its practice once and for all.

Kara, a former investment banker and executive, uses theoretical economics and business analysis to propose measures that could eradicate sex trafficking by undermining the profitability of the illegal activities associated with the crime. At considerable personal risk and expense  $\tilde{A}\phi\hat{a} - \hat{a}$  •he is nearly attacked by a gang of pimps in Mumbai  $\tilde{A}\phi\hat{a} - \hat{a}$  •the author penetrates seedy underworlds and forced labor markets to meet the women and children in the dungeon of human disgrace in Asia, Europe and the U.S. He highlights ubiquitous and disturbing trends  $\tilde{A}\phi\hat{a} - \hat{a}$  •the heavy involvement of law enforcement agencies and personnel in trafficking and slavery  $\tilde{A}\phi\hat{a} - \hat{a}$  •but this book's
