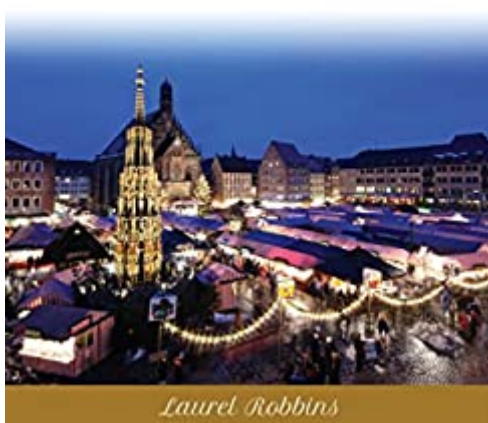

Hits many of the key words in the first few pages that pique my interest like "fairytale castles", "Christmas markets", "simple", "easy", "hidden gems", "genuine insider" and more. Gets down to the nitty gritty like going over select historic sites, restaurants, accommodations and purchasing train tickets which are both detailed and essential for having a wonderful experience. Loved the passage "If you're anything like me, sometimes the anticipation of the trip is almost just as exciting as the actual trip!" (a big YES to that) and provided me a couple of more Christmas gift ideas for my family including "The Sissi Collection" DVDS (wife will love it if anything close to German equivalent of Sound of Music) and a bottle of Glühwein for my folks (as a follow up to their European cruise this past year).
