

Hans Augusto Rey was born in Hamburg, Germany in 1898. As a child, he spent much of his free time in that city's famous Hagenbeck Zoo drawing animals. After serving in the army during World War I, he studied philology and natural science at the University of Hamburg. He then married Margret Rey and they moved to Montmartre for four years. The manuscript for the first Curious George books was one of the few items the Reys carried with them on their bicycles when they escaped from Paris in 1940. Eventually, they made their way to the United States, and Curious George was published in 1941. Curious George has been published in many languages, including French, German, Japanese, Afrikaans, and Norwegian. Additional Curious George books followed, as well as such other favorites as CECILY G. AND THE NINE MONKEYS and FIND THE CONSTELLATIONS.

Cute book that includes a fuzzy bunny, a crinkly kite, a checkered picnic blanket, a bumpy tree, and a bouncy soccer ball to touch. I would have given this 5 stars but wish the touch and feel pages were a little better on some of them. The soccer ball only has one small area that is raised and the picnic blanket doesn't really have a texture at all. I prefer the Curious George at the Zoo touch and feel book to this one, though this one is cute as well.

A great book for any Curious George fans. This one contains all of his city friends, such as Charkie. Although Jumpy Squirrel is also in this and he is usually only with George when he goes to the country.Each page features something for the child to feel. I like to ask my daughter to describe the texture. There are also a lot of bunnies throughout. It is a fun math lesson to count the bunnies. Great for ages 2-3.
