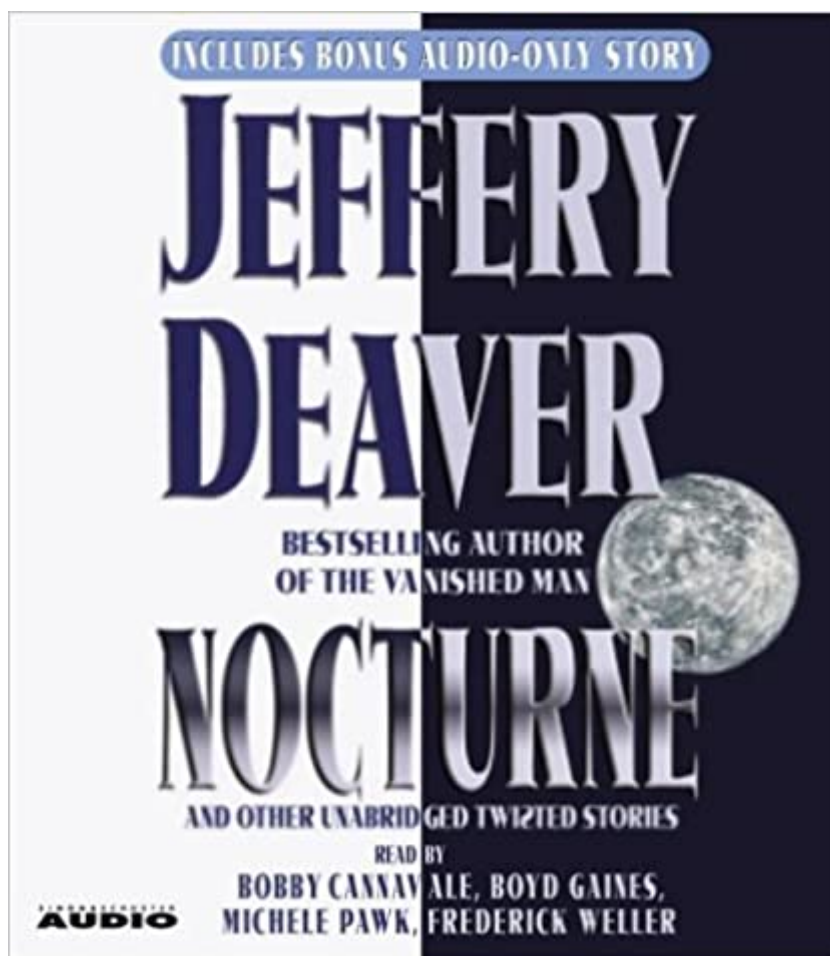

Former journalist, folksinger and attorney Jeffery Deaver's novels have appeared on a number of bestseller lists around the world, including *The New York Times*, the *Times of London* and *Los Angeles Times*. The author of eighteen novels, he's been nominated for five Edgar Awards from the *Mystery Writers of America* and an Anthony award. He is a two-time recipient of the *Ellery Queen Reader's Award for Best Short Story of the Year*, and a winner of the *British Thumping Good Read Award*. His book *A Maiden's Grave* was made into an HBO movie starring James Garner and Marlee

Matlin, and his novel *The Bone Collector* was a feature release from Universal Pictures starring Denzel Washington and Angelina Jolie. His most recent novels are *The Vanished Man*, *The Stone Monkey*, and *The Blue Nowhere*. He lives in Virginia and California.

Jeffery Deaver emerges as a master of the classic short story, bolstered by a bevy of ace readers in this collection of "twisted tales." With one exception, "All the World's a Stage," which comes off as sophomoric mock-Elizabethan prattle, this collection features intelligent, well-crafted fiction. Story lines, characters, and high stakes are melded with gripping, unexpected conclusions voiced by strong character actors. Deaver echoes O. Henry now and then when using pathos and coincidence; Poe, Hitchcock, and King when things turn dark and rife with retribution. This is a terrific book I stumbled upon by accident. If you enjoy "Twilight Zone," then you'll love these. Each story had an ending I didn't see coming. And each time I finished one, I ended up with a giant grin on my face and a big "WOW, cool!!!" I must say, I rarely like books of short stories. They're usually very uneven in quality and readability. This is the exception. This is a great book by Jeffery Deaver. Don't miss it!

The name of this book is very deceptive and makes it sound like it contains follow up stories in the vein of those in Deaver's book "Twisted" (which is also available in audio format). Lo and behold, it's actually just more stories taken from that book. This audio book should have been named something like "Nocturne and other stories from Twisted". Based on other reviews I've read, I'm not the only one to have been duped. The stories in "Twisted" are good, but jeers to the publisher for pulling this fast one.
