Yes, there were proofreading errors and it needs editing, but overall the characters were intriguing and the writing was good enough to move the plot along and keep my interest. And maybe the story was a little choppy, as if the Author was moving faster in his mind than he could transcribe into words. But this first book in the series did what it was supposed to do. It developed the World, introduced the characters, and established the plotline. I could have wished for more history and background on the Heroine before her transformation. I liked who she became, but I wanted to know more of her earlier life. Although the reader is given the facts, her feelings and core personality is skimpy.For me, It was a fast and pleasurable read. If you're looking for a Vampire/Shifter book with a strong Heroine, you may enjoy it. If you're wanting a sex -filled Paranormal Romance, you may find it lacking. At least in this first installment--not sure about the upcoming books, since I haven't read them yet. But I probably will.

I am on the 16th or is it the 17th book in this series. Everyone of them keeps you interested and looking forward to the next one. This book is the first and one of the best. I read alot and this author has spoiled me for other authors writing series. I hate to read a good book then have to wait months for the next book to come out. With Micherie Anderie the next book shows up in 30 to 45 days later and is well worth the wait. I hope this series keeps going for 30 more books and when you add in the spinoffs it may very well do that.

I bought this without bothering with reading any of the reviews except from the cursory glance at the star ratings, but I generally take those with a pinch of salt. And there is more than a bit of deus ex machina to the stream of new abilities and new technology that drop in at just the right time to solve a pressing problem. But, hey, it's fun. The editing in the first book was spotty. I just downloaded an updated copy, and the author stated in later books that he had cleaned up the editing on the first book -- so that might be improved now.I recommend the series highly. Expect to get sucked in. Enjoy the ride! Good stuff.
