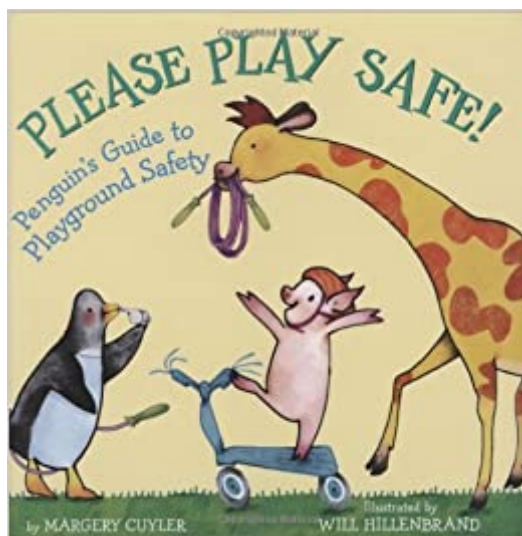

Each vignette shows the repercussions of doing something thoughtlessly - jumping off a seesaw too quickly, climbing up a slide, kicking sand - followed by the proper way to play. Children can participate in the story by replying to the question asked at the end of each don't - 'Is that right?' - with the refrain, No, that's wrong, before Penguin explains the safe way to behave.
