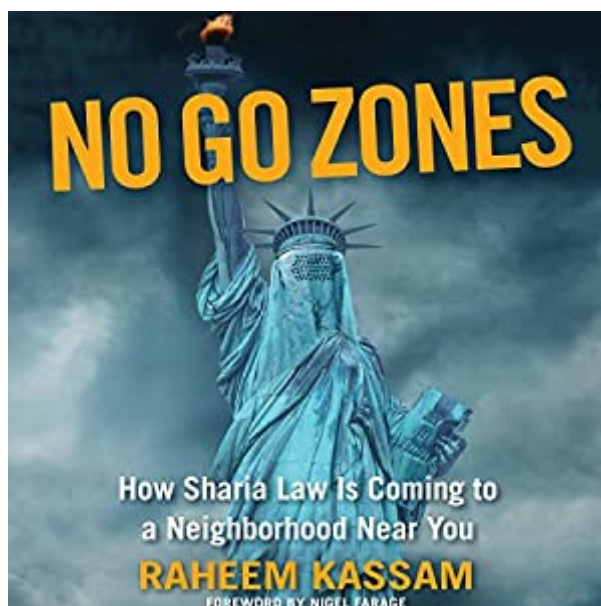

Yes, No Go Zones are real and they are incredibly dangerous to the future of Europe and humanity. No matter how much Google, YouTube, Facebook, Twitter, and other totalitarian sites censor the truth, they cannot make it go away.
