

I am a huge fan of Christy Barritt and I love the Squeaky Clean series. This book is the first of three that show us how a middle school aged Gabby St. Claire becomes the ditsy, sassy and lovable investigator we love in the full series. In this story, someone is trying to sabotage the school play and it is up to Gabby to figure out who before the play gets cancelled or someone gets hurt. Young girls will love it!

I used this book when I was homeschooling a friend's daughter. Finding books she enjoyed or getting her to read was a challenge, but she fell in love with this book. She enjoyed the books so much, that she created her own stage out of Legos to use when she gave her report on the book. She used the Lego stage and props she had constructed to "act out" the book for her report. This series is based off Christy Barritt's Squeaky Clean Series, in that the main character is Gabby St. Clair. The difference between these and the Squeaky Clean Series is that in these Gabby is in Middle School and the mysteries and crimes in these books deal more with things kid's can relate too.

I have LOVED reading all the Squeaky Clean Mysteries, so I was anxious to read about young Gabby and how she got started solving mysteries. True, it is a tween mystery, great for 4th - 6th graders maybe, but it was still fun to get some insight into Gabby's childhood. I would highly recommend it to young girls, especially if they enjoy mysteries. When I was young, I read every Nancy Drew book I could get my hands on! Unfortunately, many of the books out there today do not have good role models or moral lessons included in them, so I am glad Christy is also writing for young people.

This over-the-top middle school drama entwined with suspense, humor, and serious life questions should appeal to readers of that age. Meet Gabby St. Claire, a seventh grader who wants to survive the school year and not mess up everything she touches. Fortunately, she has one true friend to help her navigate the treacherous waters of adolescence.
