Mr. Moeller keeps improving. His Ghost universe makes for fun and easy reading, even in the earliest books, but his earlier books were marked by rather tedious repetition (how many times in

the same volume did we have to read about Caina's "whole body snapping" when knife-throwing?), often sloppy writing, and overly cartoonish figures. I enjoyed the stories, but longed for the intervention of a good copy editor. I am happy to say that the writing style has been improving for some time and is the best to date in this book; repeated expressions and cliches are (nearly) absent; and surviving "good guy" figures (as well as some new ones), are getting more fully fleshed out and more believable. Keep up the good work!

God, I love Caina Amalas. I love every book and story in this series. And, in this book we are gifted with a storyline that takes her into the territory that I've wanted to see her going into ever since Kylon Shipbreaker first appeared. This is a typical Ghosts story, with all the unbelievable action and near death escapes that we've seen in all of the books so far. We're getting closer and closer to the end of this particular plotline, and Caina gets closer to unraveling and destroying Callatas' endeavors. She understands what his "apostheosis" is, and how she is going to end it. She knows how to find the relics that Annarah is hiding, where Annarah is, and how to reach her. The next book is going to be heartstopping in its drama and action. What is particularly great in this book, is that Caina and Kylon are finally drawing closer together into a love relationship. He is the one that she has always been meant for, and I've been waiting with very little patience, for Moeller to get around to writing this book. Now, we're getting somewhere. The two of them together are not quite yet, but will be, the absolute pairing that this series has always ached for. Corvalis was not the man for her. He simply wasn't strong enough, or noble enough, for Caina. If I knew it, then everyone else must have seen that. It's always been Kylon. Now that the two of them are discovering this about themselves. I think the world will be saved much more efficiently and quickly than it has been up to now. I'd, honestly, hate to see the end of this series come, since it has taken over my imagination for some time, now. I obsessively stalk Moeller's page waiting for the new episodes. But, I have the female urgency for completion, and I really want to see these two become a pair, and then save the world. I know it's going to happen. Several old familiar characters appear in this book. Nasser and Laertas, Damla, Nerina Strake and Azaces. If you remember Morgant the Razor from a previous short story, then you'll be gratified to find that he has become an important member of the crew. Though we've lost Halfdan and the Malarea Ghost group, we've gained a whole new group of characters who are more than worthy to continue this tale. I've read a lot of Moeller's other work, and have liked it all, but the Ghosts books are my absolute favorites. Caina, the Ghost assassin, is a character for the ages. And, Moeller has relaxed into her story in a way that is less stilted than in the beginning, and more richly detailed and intuitive. Caina lives and breathes for me. I will drop

everything else in my queue when a new book shows up. I thought that the Ghosts story was drawing to a close when Caina was banished from Malarea by the surprisingly weak emperor that she had lived her life to serve. I was happy beyond expression when I discovered that Moeller had lots of new plans for her. I could, (and would) simply reread everything over and over, but now there is so much more happening. I have to take it on faith that Moeller will continue to find new challenges for her, even after she has saved the world from this current threat. Especially with Kylon at her side. 5 Star book. For lots of reasons. Mostly because I just love these characters and this story. It's not about the quality of the writing. It's about the imagination required to visualize this story and bring it into existence. Moeller has enough imagination to do this. His other series are also addictive. But -- this one is special.

Introduces an interesting new character, brings back one I liked. Moeller doesn't move the overarching plot forward as much as he could have, focusing on the characters more (not a complaint; just an observation), although he expands the background a bit and lays the groundwork for the next in the series. Moeller's prose is good; not Gaiman or Wright but he won't put casual readers off, either. I'd recommend this for anyone who enjoys fantasy.

Some you'll hate, some you'll love but they're all well-crafted and interesting. I love that this series features a smart, capable woman as the protagonist.
