As an Anglican (ACNA) I Acknowledge that I am certain to be biased in my review just as someone in the TEC would be. However, I am very grateful for the rich liturgical heritage that we have and continue to develop in.However, the recent liturgical innovations that TEC has developed has been less than faithful to anglican liturgical practices let alone christian practices. Of the many shortcomings of this work (there are many) I will only focus on the two major problems. 1st This work is a grave misrepresentation of the benedictine liturgy of the hours and the Anglican form of breviary. This can be seen in changing the overall tone in the hours $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}c\tilde{A}$ $\hat{a} \neg \tilde{A}$ $\hat{a}_{,,c}$ liturgical texts with subtitlesInstead of meditating on the life and death of Jesus (resurrection for lauds etc.) Lauds is now just called $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}c\tilde{A}$ $\hat{a} \neg \tilde{A}$ \hat{A} "praise $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}c\tilde{A}$ $\hat{a} \neg \tilde{A}$ \hat{A} • (without the resurrection)The rest of the hours are named after internal $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}\phi\tilde{A} \ \hat{a} \neg \tilde{A} \ \hat{A}$ "feelings $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}\phi\tilde{A} \ \hat{a} \neg \tilde{A} \ \hat{A}$ • without any deeper connection to the mystery of Christ and the Cross. Second and most problematic is the number of pagan prayers included in this $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}\phi\tilde{A} \ \hat{a} \neg \tilde{A} \ \hat{A}$ "Christian $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}\phi\tilde{A} \ \hat{a} \neg \tilde{A} \ \hat{A}$ • work. The most blatant of this is the three native American (non-Christian) prayers, the inclusion of a Taoist Chinese poem and a meditation from a Buddhist monk. As baptized Christians, we lay aside the ways of the world and are called to be transformed into the people of God. Many liturgical works from TEC however, lack the courage to call for a transformational Christian life and instead opt for an affirmational Christian worldview which negates the counter-cultural message of Christ. In Short, the work is affirmational in nature instead of transformational. One is better suited to look elsewhere for spiritual direction and devotion.

This book presents an interesting effort to make daily prayer more accessable. Yet prayers seem stilted rather than straightforward. It is worth the effort, however, and the affirmations are very helpful.

You may possibly not spend your hard-earned money on multiple prayer books - but I do. I use them every day and like to have variety AND really well-written, edited collections of daily prayers. This one is not new, but I had not looked at it. It is really different from any others I've seen, yet nothing gimmicky. It is based upon the Episcopalian Book of Common Prayer. It has a week's worth of prayers for every liturgical season of the year (Advent, Christmas, Lent, Ordinary Time et al.) Each time of day has a brief but fairly comprehensive set of prayers. Some are even hymns to be sung, although it doesn't contain the melodies. It tells where you can find them.For something that has the right "feel," namely that these are real prayers, not just made up to sound nice, that don't drag on and on, that cover the whole of life, but in several days, not all at once, that actually use different points of view, that are not just like everything else, I recommend this book. It is small and light, too, so you could carry it with you.

I very much enjoy new prayers in the tradition. They sparkle and after six decades of reading BoC, I appreciate a bit of a variation. I can see that it bothers some who want to recite the same words all of the time. I insert Holy Ghost rather than Holy Spirit half of the time at church, so I do understand.I can't pray the hours, which is a bit frustrating and I do Morning Prayer most days but this is a nice addition.It is a good value for me.
